The Carl & Roberta Deutsch Foundation honors nonprofit organizations serving in Los Angeles County each year with the HALO Award, a capacity building effort to strengthen and sustain nonprofit organizations by supporting volunteer programs and to recognize and reward volunteers doing exemplary work in their communities.
